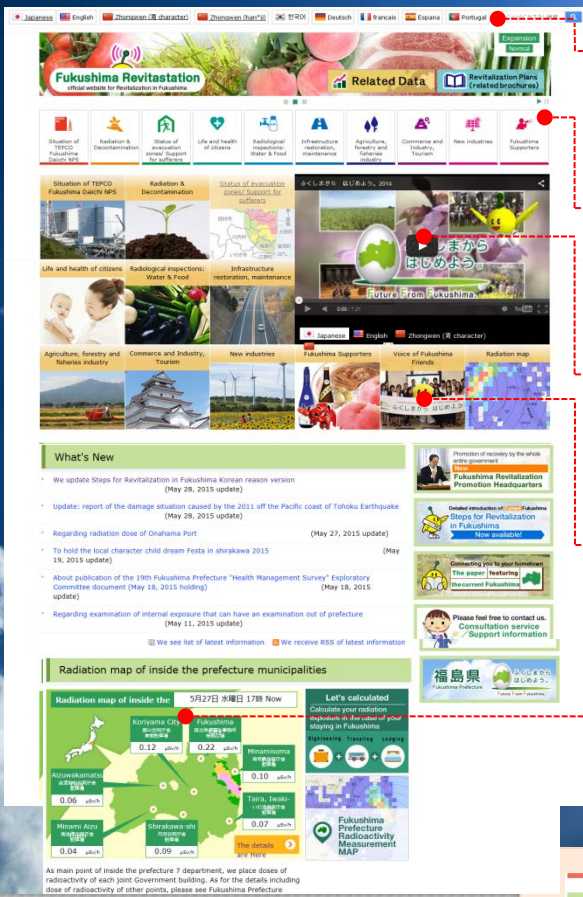

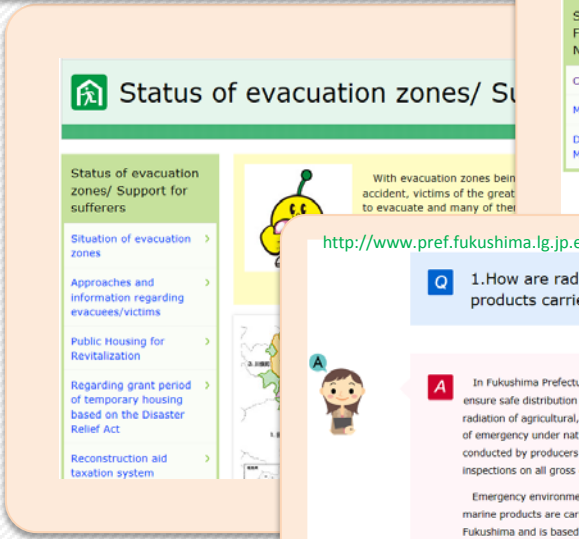

In Fukushima Daiichi NPS, decommissioning work is in progress based on medium-and-long term road map planned by the government and TEPCO. In order to make sure that decommissioning work is being carried out in a safe and steady way, prefectural government inspects the progress closely through field work and meetings.

Q 1. How are radiation screenings on farm products carried out?

A In Fukushima Prefecture, a system for testing radiation in farm products to ensure safe distribution and consumption is set in place where environmental radiation of agricultural, forestry and marine products are monitored in times of emergency under national guidelines, as well as voluntary inspections conducted by producers at production centers including but not limited to inspections on all gross quantity bags of rice.

Emergency environmental radiation monitoring on agriculture, forestry and marine products are carried out in all affected cities and prefectures, including Fukushima and is based on "concepts of inspection, planning and the establishment and cancellation of items and areas to which the restrictions of distribution and/or the consumption of foods concerned applies" that the Nuclear Emergency Response Headquarters (General manager: Prime Minister) of the national government established.
