**Modification No. 1 to the Practical Arrangements
on Fukushima Prefecture Initiative Projects**

between

Fukushima Prefecture

and

The International Atomic Energy Agency

This Modification No. 1 to the Practical Arrangements on Fukushima Initiative Projects is made between Fukushima Prefecture, whose address is 2-16 Sugitsuma-cho, Fukushima City, Fukushima Prefecture 960-8670, Japan; and the International Atomic Energy Agency (hereinafter also referred to as the "IAEA"), an intergovernmental organization established by its Statute, whose address is Vienna International Centre, P.O. Box 100, 1400 Vienna, Austria. Fukushima Prefecture and the IAEA are hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Parties".

WHEREAS the Practical Arrangements on Fukushima Prefecture Initiative Projects were signed on 25 March 2013 by the IAEA and on 10 April 2013 by Fukushima Prefecture (hereinafter referred to as the "Practical Arrangements");

WHEREAS the Parties desire to modify the Practical Arrangements to include two additional projects in Paragraph 2 ("Scope of Cooperation") of the Practical Arrangements;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties have reached a common recognition on the following:

1. Paragraph 2 ("Scope of Cooperation") of the Practical Arrangements is hereby modified to include the below listed projects and activities that may be undertaken:
 - “4. Development of environmental mapping technology using GPS walking surveys; and
 5. Project for the study of promoting the proper treatment of waste containing radioactive materials at municipal solid waste incinerators.”
2. Except as provided in Paragraph 1 of this Modification No. 1, all other paragraphs of the Practical Arrangements will remain unchanged.
3. This Modification No. 1 will be valid on the date of the last signature by or on behalf of the Parties and will remain valid for the duration of the Practical Arrangements.
