2018 Annual Japan Sake Awards Announced

Fukushima sake becomes the first prefecture in Japan to be awarded "Best Sake in Japan" for the 6th consecutive year! ~Fukushima Sake Awarded 19 Gold Prizes~

On May 17th, 2018 the results of the Annual Japan Sake Awards was announced. Out of 850 entries from across the country, 31 Fukushima sake received awards, with 19 of those earning a Gold Prize. This marks the sixth consecutive year Fukushima Prefecture has held the title of "Best Sake in Japan" by earning the most Gold Prizes of any prefecture (and the 8th time to hold the title overall). This is the first time in the century-old contest this has happened.

This year was the 106th Annual Japan Sake Awards contest (the first was in 1911). Each sake brewery may only submit one sake for evaluation.
